

## One Day Events

### Community Health Fair/Informational Booth

- Distribution of tobacco prevention/cessation information
- Demonstration of activities included within the STAT curriculum
- Encouraging children to sign a "Just say no to tobacco" commitment card

### Distribution of STAT Pamphlet to Pediatrician and Family Practice offices

- Production and distribution of a pamphlet including STAT program information, pictures of tobacco-affected lungs and/or oral cavities, age-appropriate games/puzzles with a tobacco prevention/cessation message, STAT contact information/website address

### National/regional/state/city promotional contest

- Host a tobacco prevention/cessation contest in your community, state, or nation-wide

### Host a STAT assembly in your local schools

- Host a student assembly in your community as a stand-alone one day event

### Organize a tobacco prevention and cessation fun run/walk in your community

- Raise money for the American Cancer Society or other charity organization while getting kids involved in an event to increase community awareness about a non-tobacco lifestyle

### Host or sponsor a "Tobacco-Free Day" at a local community event

- Pick a sporting event, carnival, or other children's event to distribute tobacco prevention/cessation information
- Perform demonstrations with kids borrowed from the STAT curriculum
- Pass out STAT stickers or promotional items
- Involve a speaker- possibly a cancer survivor
